

HEALTHINFOSTAT.COM PRIVACY POLICY

Last Updated on July 4, 2007.

The HealthInfoSTAT.com web site (the "Site") is a service of Health Infostat, LLC, a Missouri limited liability company ("Health InfoSTAT" or "we"). This Privacy Policy applies only to information that we collect from users of the Site about such users.

We may revise this Privacy Policy at any time. When we do, we will also revise the "Last Updated" date at the top of this Privacy Policy. You are responsible for regularly reviewing the current Privacy Policy. The most current version of the Privacy Policy can be reviewed by clicking on the "Privacy Policy" hypertext link located at the bottom of our web pages. Your continued use of the Site after we post any revisions constitutes your agreement to any such revisions.

What information do we collect from this Site?

Information that is automatically collected by this Site may include, without limitation, the internet site from which you linked to this Site and your IP address.

Personally identifiable information is information that tells us who you are such as your name, birth date and your e-mail address. We may collect this information when you register to use this Site and when you enter and/or modify information that is maintained on the Site, whether directly or through the use of our Solace by Health InfoSTAT software. We may associate information that is automatically collected with your personally identifiable information.

How do we use the information that we collect?

We use personally identifiable information for the purpose for which it was obtained (e.g., to establish your account and/or to charge you for any products or services that you may acquire). We may also use personally identifiable information to send you emails about the Site, respond to e-mails, provide customer support, and other similar matters. If you so choose, such information might be used for us to send you promotional e-mails about goods and services that may be of interest to you including promotional e-mails on behalf of selected third parties about goods and services that may be of interest to you. However, when we do this, we will not disclose your personally identifiable information (such as your e-mail address) to any such third party.

We may use automatic information to customize your experience while visiting the Site, to evaluate and improve the design of the Site, to track the value of our marketing sources, and tell us what country you are located in.

We may use non-personally identifiable aggregate information to help us run and maintain the Site, study traffic patterns and generally learn about the usage of the Site. We may also use such information for purposes of system administration, to improve the design and content of the Site, and/or to enable us to personalize your Internet experience.

How the information collected is disclosed?

Except as provided in this Privacy Policy, (a) we do not sell, rent or trade with unaffiliated third parties any personally identifiable information that you provide to us through the Site (including information contained in your member health profile), and (b) we do not share such information with third parties.

We may disclose personally identifiable information if you consent. For example, if you are a member of our personal health record service available on the Site, in our terms of use (www.healthinfostat.com/termsOfUse.asp) you consent to (a) our release of all personal health record, confidential and/or other information to the individuals and/or entities to whom you give an access code or others that you designate to us, and (b) our release of any personal health record, confidential and/or other information necessary to satisfy the law, regulation, or government request.

We may disclose personally identifiable information to third parties who provide services to us and who agree to maintain such information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. These third parties may provide a variety of services to us including, without limitation, hosting this Site, processing and storing user information, updating your customer information records in our database, and sending or coordinating the sending of marketing communications on our behalf. We do not authorize such third parties to make any other use of your information.

We may disclose personally identifiable information in special cases when we have reason to believe that disclosing such information is necessary to identify, contact, or bring legal action against someone who may have breached our Terms of Use (www.healthinfostat.com/termsOfUse.asp) or who may be causing injury to or interference with (either intentionally or unintentionally) our rights or property, other users of the Site, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities. We may also disclose personally identifiable information when we reasonably believe that the law requires it.

We may sell or buy subsidiaries, or business units. In such transactions, personally identifiable information generally is one of the transferred business assets but remains subject to any pre-existing Privacy Policy. Also, in the unlikely event that some or all of the assets of Health InfoSTAT are sold, personally identifiable information may be one of the transferred assets.

We may disclose non-personally identifiable information in aggregate form to third parties including, without limitation, advertisers and business partners.

Do you have a choice as to whether to provide information to us?

You can choose not to provide personally identifiable information to us. However, if you do not provide such information, the Site (and the underlying service) may not function as intended.

Can you access your information?

If you are a registered user, you can access, change, correct, and update the personally identifiable information, health profile information and reference documents that you publish this Site through your account.

How do we protect the security of your information?

We work to protect the security of your personally identifiable information during transmission to us by using software, which encrypts information you input. We also work to protect the security of your personally identifiable information stored in our systems by storing some personally identifiable information in encrypted form. You help to maintain the security of your personally identifiable information stored in our systems by keeping your username and password confidential and protecting against unauthorized access to your password and to your computer. Be sure to sign off when finished using a shared computer. Unfortunately, although we employ such security measures, information transmitted on the Internet and/or stored on systems connected to the Internet is not 100% secure. As a result, we do not ensure, warrant or guarantee the security or integrity of such information.

How do we protect a child's privacy?

The Site is a general audience web site. We do not intentionally collect personally identifiable information from users of this Site who are under the age of thirteen.

Does the Site contain links to other web sites?

While you are using the Site, you may be linked or directed to other third party sites outside of the Site that are beyond our control. Each of these third parties may have a privacy policy different from ours. Please review the privacy policies of these sites.
